Terry Matilsky

Terry Matilsky had been a professor in the Department of Physics and Astronomy for 41 years, starting in 1976. In 2017, he retired and became Professor Emeritus.

One of the first things he did after arriving at Rutgers was start an account at the RFCU, which was then housed in the “barracks” at Livingston. He has seen the credit union thrive over the decades, by focusing on friendliness, developing personal relationships with members, and providing customer service far beyond what we see in the commercial banking world. He has served on the Rutgers Federal Credit Union Board of Directors for about 25 years.
